

Siemens Turkey Information Security Policy

Information assets, which constitutes valuable company know-how and brings added value to our stakeholders, are created, processed, shared and stored on various media in order to fulfill our business goals. Our business processes are highly dependent on the information and communication systems on which such information is processed.

We are committed to the protection of these important assets together with the supporting processes, and to an effective and efficient information security management for our competitiveness, business continuity and new business models.

The overall objective of information security is to safeguard confidentiality, integrity of sensitive company information, as well as the availability of information and communication systems at an appropriate level. Beyond Siemens rules and common best practice, this level is identified for our information assets by information security risk management, which allows a suitable balance to be drawn between risks and measures.

The information security management in our company uses the ISO 27001 standard for Information Security Management System (ISMS) as a reference and ensures compliance with all relevant internal and external regulations.

All managers are responsible for ensuring information security in their area, and all employees are obliged to protect the information they access and the information and communication systems they use against loss, falsification, misuse, as well as to report security incidents in compliance with the company rules. The personnel, who violate these rules and cause potential damage, may face administrative consequences.

This policy and the information security rules will be accessible to all related parties and our employees, and it is ensured that they are aware of our commitments and the content of this policy.

Management and the unit information security representatives will ensure the continual improvement of the ISMS by regularly reviews for effectivity and efficiency.
